




1. Log in to the Student Dormitory System

- Use Academic Information Systems account credentials
- ► Enter captcha




2. Agreement and Contact

Select application items




3. Start Application - Academic Year Housing





3. Start Application - Summer Housing

- Undergraduate students submit application directly









4. Update Application

- Click on "Complete" to enter update.
 - Adjust the dormitory preferences order and update the application.
 - Cancel application (if you wish to reapply, please ensure it is completed within the application period).






5. Confirm Application

- Confirm Application Status
 - Start: Not submitted or application has been canceled.
 - Application: Application is complete.
- ▶ Received email for application confirmation, update, and cancellation.





Housing Application QA

Q1: Why Was the Application Process Changed This Year?

- With the College of Education relocating to the main campus in the academic year 2025, the dormitory policies have been adjusted accordingly. Since the current dormitory capacity at the main campus cannot accommodate all students from both campuses, and the College of Arts has not yet moved to the main campus, its students will continue attending classes at the Nanda Campus and will be assigned dormitory spaces there. Students from other colleges, however, will have the option to choose dormitories at both the main campus and the Nanda Campus.
- This adjustment aims to allocate bed spaces more fairly and reasonably, align with the university's overall policy, and address related concerns. To ensure fairness in dormitory allocation, a unified lottery system has been implemented. This change also simplifies the application process, improves efficiency, and allows students to receive their dormitory lottery results as early as possible.

Q2: Who has priority?

- Priority qualification for student housing in National Tsing Hua University is subject to the order of precedence as follows:
- Students eligible for priority housing qualification
 - Foreign freshmen and undergraduate freshmen are eligible for priority housing qualification.
 - Other priority housing qualifications: In accordance with the "Enforcement Rules of Other Priority Dormitory Qualification of National Tsing Hua University".
 - If there are not enough beds for second-year undergraduate students and current graduate students, they shall be arranged randomly by computer drawing.

Q3: Can student with priority choose their dormitory first?

- Priority qualification only grants the right to obtain housing, not the right to choose the campus and dormitory.
- In the past, the application process reserved some dormitory beds for students without priority eligibility, while students with priority eligibility could select dormitories first, and the remaining beds would be made available to those without priority eligibility. Especially after the merging of the two campuses' dormitories, it became difficult to determine how many beds should be reserved for students from each campus. Priority eligibility refers to the right to secure accommodation, not the right to prioritize dormitory selection.
- Therefore, this adjustment means that all students who have secured accommodation rights (whether or not they have priority eligibility) will apply individually. A computer-generated random draw will be used to assign serial numbers, and based on these numbers, students will be allocated their preferred dormitories, ensuring fairness.

Q4: Can I bind groups?

- Before the academic year 2024, many students reported issues with the group application method. Students with priority were unable to apply together with those without priority. Some students gave up their priority status to apply with their friends, only to end up not securing a dormitory spot, leading to further complications. To prevent these issues, the application process has been changed to an individual-based system this year. This ensures a fairer allocation of dormitory spaces and protects students' rights.
- Additionally, dormitory buildings have different room types, and allowing group applications could lead to imbalances in bed allocation, which is another important factor considered in this change.

Q5: Can I stay with my current roommate?

- If you are assigned to different dormitories, you can participate in the dormitory exchange process during the designated period.
- Those who are allocated to the same dormitory can register and arrange their room and bed assignments during the designated period set by the dorm head resident, following the dormitory's allocation guidelines.

Q6: Can I choose a quiet room or a single room/suite?

- The application period has been moved earlier so students can get their results sooner.
 Quiet rooms (for undergraduate students) and single rooms/suites (for graduate students) are now included in the dormitory selection process, eliminating the need for a second application.
- Undergraduate students, regardless of priority status, will be assigned quiet rooms through the random selection process. This prevents quiet rooms from being occupied solely by students with priority.
- Graduate students only need to submit one application. If they do not secure a single room or suite, the system will automatically assign them to their next preferred option, ensuring they do not miss out due to a forgotten application. These changes simplify the process, improve fairness, and help students receive their results faster.

Q7: Does the dormitory preference order (including quiet rooms) affect the chances of students without priority being assigned accommodation rights?

- No, it does not affect the chances of those without priority in obtaining accommodation rights.
- Students without priority will be randomly assigned accommodation rights based on the number of applicants.
